Illinois Capacitor is committed to complying with all national and international law, rules and regulations regarding Human rights.

Illinois Capacitor does not purchase tin, tantalum, tungsten or gold directly from smelters or mines. There are multiple levels of suppliers between Illinois Capacitor and the smelters and mines from which metals are sourced. Illinois Capacitor has required its suppliers perform due diligence to validate the source of the materials used in our capacitors be from smelters who are EICC Conflict-Free smelters or other acceptable smelters that comply with EICC requirements.

Illinois Capacitor Confirms to the best of our knowledge that none of the capacitors we produce contain materials purchased or supplied by the democratic Republic of Congo or any of the adjoining countries as required in section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.
